The schools will begin at 9 a.m. and adjourn at 2.30 p.m., including a Farmer panel at the end of the School.

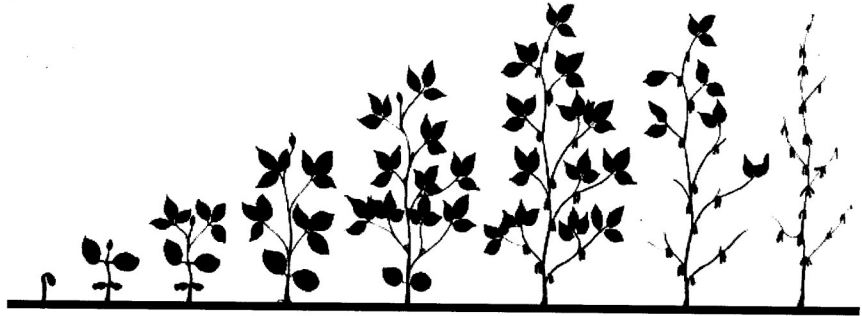
